

Marine Biochemists**NOTICE OF APPLICATION
FOR AQUATIC PLANT
MANAGEMENT PERMIT**

Marine Biochemists, on behalf of riparian owners along the shores of Pewaukee Lake, intend to apply for a permit from the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources to treat up to 36 acres of water in Pewaukee Lake with Navigate Herbicide to control Eurasian Watermilfoil. The proposed treatment would occur between July 17 and September 30, 2007.

Treatments will occur only along those properties desiring, and signed up for treatment, as listed on the Aquatic Plant Management (APM) permit application.

The permit applicant will conduct a public informational meeting on the proposed treatment if five or more individuals, organizations, special units of government, or local units of government request one. The meeting would give interested parties a chance to learn more about the proposed treatment from the permit applicant. The permit applicant is not required to, but may, change the proposed treatment based on information provided by citizens attending the meeting.

Any request for a public meeting on this proposed treatment must be made within five (5) days after this notice is published. The request **MUST SPECIFY** the topics to be discussed at the meeting, including the problems and alternatives, and must be sent in writing to Marine Biochemists, 6316 W. Eastwood Ct., Mequon, WI 53092, and to the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources, 141 NW Barstow, RM 180, Waukesha, WI 53188, Attn.: Andy Hudak.

This Public Notice is required by Chapter NR107, Wisconsin Administrative Code.
